**Re: NeXGen Date and Time**

Allied always recommends that our integrators make full use of the ANDI specification. This includes giving integrators the ability to program the date and time via the interface.

This allows the **NeXGen Forecourt Controller** to remain in sync with the POS and other devices on the network segment, which can be important to maintain correct transaction dates and times as well as accurate receipt data.

Additionally, ensuring correct and accurate date & time is **critical** when reviewing site data for troubleshooting purposes.

The date & time can also be set automatically when using the Allied Communicator and Allied's DGS program.
